GUIDELINES FOR UNDERGRADUATE RE-ENROLLMENT

SUSPENDED STUDENTS FOLLOW THESE ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:

Harpur College of Arts and Sciences

Suspension lasts for two major semesters. Student suspended for the second time is not eligible to return. Contact the Academic Advising o ce at 607-777-6305 to appeal dismissal.

Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences

Decker College of Nursing and Health Sciences admissions committee will review the application to determine if student is eligible for re-enrollment.

College of Community and Public A airs

Suspension lasts for one major semester. Student who has been out on suspension and whose GPA is under the academic dismissal index will return under a contract.

School of Management

School of Management will review the application to determine if student is eligible for re-enrollment.

Watson College of Engineering and Applied Science

Suspension lasts for one major semester. A third suspension is considered dismissal. Student must petition the Watson College Academic A airs Committee in writing to appeal dismissal.

RE-ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

Contact your academic advisor after you receive your re-enrollment acceptance letter.

Obtain your student ID card from the o ce of Financial Aid and Student Records. It is required for access to many buildings and on-campus services.

Complete the Student Code of Conduct acknowledgement online (if you haven't already done so)

Register for classes (Note: For Summer or Winter Session registrations, visit binghamton. edu/summer or binghamton.edu/winter)

Contact Financial Aid prior to the start of classes if you are seeking aid.

Contact Residential Life for information about on-campus housing.

Contact Student Accounts to make payment arrangements.

Confirm your enrollment via BU BRAIN.

For online courses, set-up Brightspace access at Computing Services (computing. binghamton.edu).

If you are an international student, and will return to Binghamton on an F-1 or J-1 visa, contact the O ce of International Student and Scholar Services for additional requirements.
